During its peak in Pennsylvania in 1980, over 65,000 lives were lost to abortion. That's a near-stadium capacity of the Pittsburgh Steelers or Philadelphia Eagles football teams gone due to abortion in just one year.

Since then, advancements have been made and many have taken a stand to defend the sanctity of life:

Ultrasounds provide a window into the womb. Since 2004, Focus on the Family's Option Ultrasound program has shown pregnant moms their baby in the womb, which has helped save over 465,000 babies.

Pregnancy Resource Centers established. Across the Commonwealth, compassionate staff are counseling and supporting financially moms who choose life.

Abortion locations closed. At least twenty-five (25) abortion facilities have closed in Pennsylvania since 2010. This represents ten on-site abortion clinics - including the infamous "House of Horrors" Women's Medical Society clinic run by Kermit Gosnell - along with fifteen Planned Parenthood "feeder" clinics.
